Barnardo's Scotland Welcome (Ukraine) Service is ready to launch their Ukrainian Youth Network! We recognise some of the difficulties young Ukrainians are facing and therefore we are introducing a safe, digital space for 13–19-year-olds to come together, socialise and have fun. The Ukrainian Youth Network ultimately aims to help young Ukrainians to feel part of a wider community, reduce loneliness/boredom and improve their overall mental health and wellbeing. Additionally, as it is a digital space, it will allow connections to continue if families relocate elsewhere in Scotland.

Each month we will offer a range of activities for Ukrainian young people to participate in, and we will be introducing youth ambassadors who will help to influence and develop our network and support to ensure this group's needs are being met.
