BEHAVIOUR

Behaviour in the community: Pupils are reminded that school expectations regarding behaviour extends to break and lunchtime times. If you are going into town for lunch make sure you are back to the school by 1.50pm, keep street /community areas free of litter, and stay off university grounds.

Bus Behaviour: It has been brought our attention that the behaviour of some individuals on the buses is not what we would expect. When we are aware of incidents these are dealt with in school but we would appreciate your support in reminding your young person of the following:

Please get on the bus you have been allocated

Follow instructions from the driver

Remain seated

Ensure your conduct towards others is always respectful.

We have high expectations of all our young people and expect them to continue these when representing Madras college both on the buses and within the community.

Reminders:

Latest Covid advice for young people is (those aged 18 and under) that those with mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough - but who are otherwise well - do not need to stay at home and can continue to attend education settings. They should only stay at home if they are unwell and have a high temperature. They can go back to school, college or childcare, and resume normal activities when they no longer have a fever and they feel well enough to attend.

School Uniform - All young people are expected to wear school uniform including blazers and ties at all times, ties can be purchased from the school office at a cost of £4. Any young person who requires support from the school with regards to uniform should see their guidance teacher in the first instance. All young people should change into and out of PE kit following PE lessons.

Change of timetable for session 22/23 : School planning for the new timetable continues at pace and the planned date for change of timetable will be Tuesday 7th June, following the Jubilee holiday which is on Friday 3rd June.

CORRIDORS: The first, second and home economics/tech corridors should not be use during break and lunchtimes. Please only use the canteen and outdoor areas, this will ensure areas are kept quiet for exams. Our S3 prefects will be monitoring these areas and all pupils should follow any instructions given by the prefects. Pupils should only be in corridors if they are going to see a specific teacher, however, please be mindful of exams taking place and take note of any signage.
