### Reminders:

**Latest Covid advice** for young people is (those aged 18 and under) that those with mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough - but who are otherwise well - do not need to stay at home and can continue to attend education settings. They can go back to school, college or childcare, and resume normal activities when they no longer have a fever and they feel well enough to attend.
