## GENERAL RULES OF COMPETITION.

*Scoring:* For the Inter-Command competition, scoring will be:

Individual Events—5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Team Events—10, 8, 6, 4, 2. Discus, Weight and Javelin will not count for Points.

The following Trophies will be awarded:—"ELVIN CUP," presented by A. J. ELVIN, Esq., for Champion Command in Junior Competition; "CRITCHLEY CUP," presented by Brigadier-General A. C. CRITCHLEY, C.M.G., C.B.E., D.S.O., for Champion Command in Senior Competition; "A.T.C. GAZETTE CUP," presented by A.T.C. GAZETTE for Champion Command in Combined Senior and Junior Competitions.

Certificates will be awarded to the first three in each event, but the first individual or winning team in any event only will be presented with certificate at conclusion of Meeting.

*Finals:*

No substitution will be allowed for finals.

*Stations:*

Order of stations at start of Heats will be as per programme.

*Long Jump:*

Each competitor will be allowed three trials. The best three competitors at the end of the first round will be allowed three more trials.

## NOTICE TO COMPETITORS.

Competitors should report to Competitors Stewards at track entrance to tunnel 10 minutes prior to their event (heat or final). After competing cadets must retire to the stands or dressing rooms. "Warming up" may be allowed within 15 minutes of the start of an event.

Competitors in the 4 x 110 relay must keep to their respective lanes. The Medley Relay will be run in the following order: 440, 220, 220, 880, only the 440 leg being staggered.

Each Winner of a Final should report to the Recorders Table immediately after his event.

Competitors in Event No. 1 (Junior Long Jump) will not take part in Parade but will obtain numbers in dressing room and proceed to centre of arena. All other competitors will parade without numbers and return after Parade to dressing rooms, where they will be handed numbers. No competitor will be allowed on the track without numbers.
